ECONOMIC & SOCIAL COHESION ACTION PLAN (2019-2020)

Work Areas & Actions

1. Support & promotion of initiatives for a **sustainable, inclusive and smart socio-economic development** in the Mediterranean
 - Promotion and development of Social and Solidarity entrepreneurship
 - Sustainable tourism promotion as a trigger for sustainable, cultural, economic development
2. Promotion of specific actions in favour of **democracy and citizenship, youth and intercultural dialogue**.
 - Support training, mobility, integration, employment access for young people in the Med (VdG TF)
 - Intensify intercultural dialogue & mutual understanding between the North and the South
 - Promote citizenship and democracy in the Mediterranean towards a common identity
3. Fostering a **Cohesion Policy** that tackles the Mediterranean regions' challenges:
 - Contribution to the CPMR analysis on the future of the Cohesion Policy of the EU and promotion of the application of these principles in the Neighbourhood Policy
 - Support to Macro-regional strategies: the WESTMED Initiative and EUSAIR Strategy

CPMR “Vasco da Gama” Initiative (launched in 2010 – GA Aberdeen)

- ❖ AIM → develop the **attractiveness of maritime careers** among Europeans, through transnational **mobility & training for young people** in different sectors of the maritime economy.

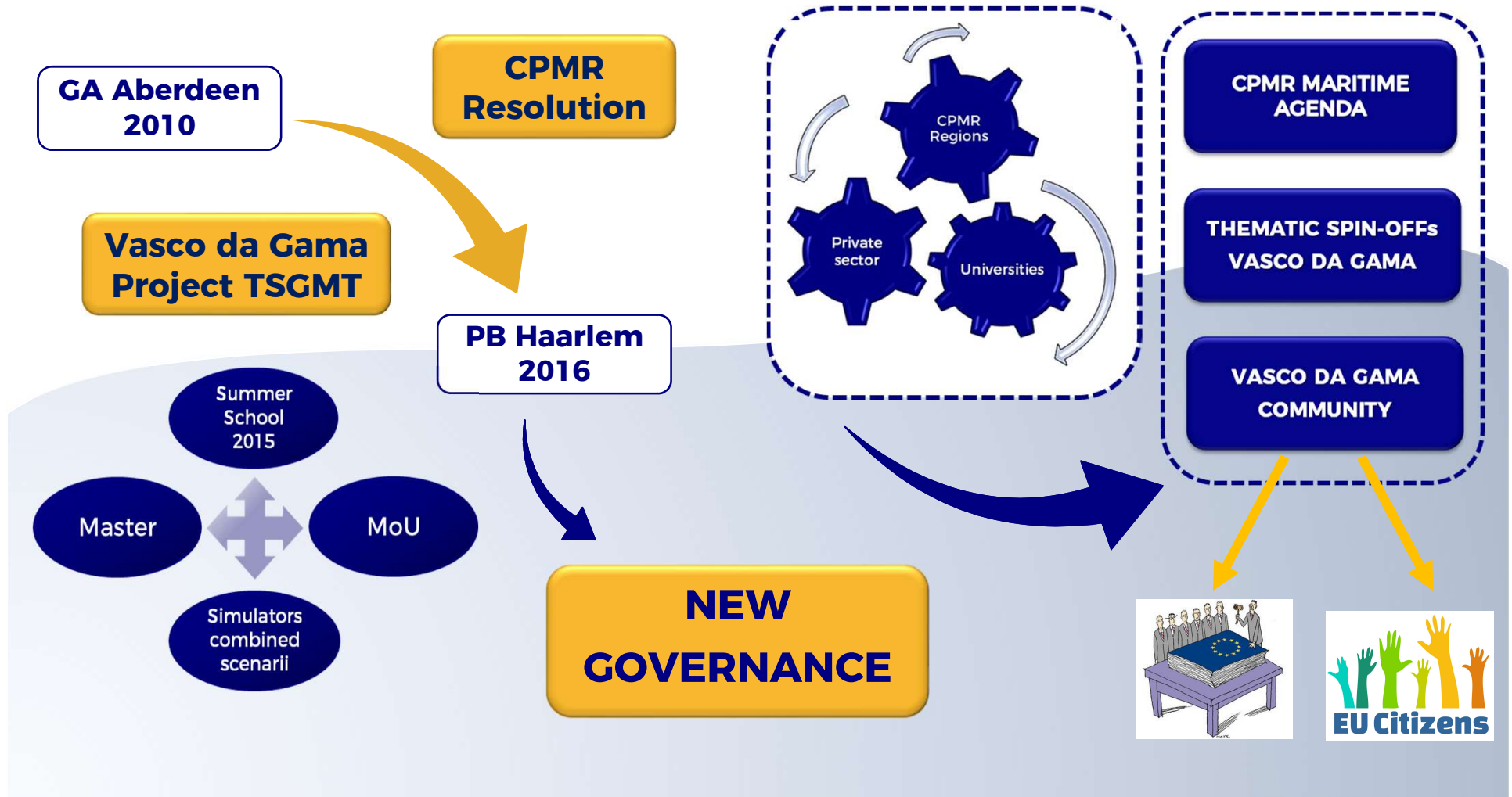
DG MOVE Project “Vasco da Gama: *training for greener and safer maritime transport*” (2014-2016)

- ❖ In line with Integrated Maritime Policy and within the main objectives of the European Maritime Transport Policy - fostering competitiveness and promote a safe and green system - the project contributed to achieving the **development of high professional skills and the development of education and training conditions** within the EU to ensure efficient, safe, secure and environmentally shipping operations and the overall efficiency of the transport chain.
- ❖ The project was divided into 4 operational WPs: (1) training for maritime safety, (2) training on maritime simulators, (3) greening maritime transport, (4) a maritime Erasmus.
- ❖ The project led to the creation of the IMC Vasco da Gama Task Force.

“Vasco da Gama” IMC Task Force (created in 2015)

- ❖ The TF represents the declination of the CPMR political initiative at Med level.
- ❖ The TF participated in the final phase of sharing the VdG TGSMT project.
- ❖ It intends to continue working on the topic of **training and mobility concerning Sea professions in the Mediterranean**, by producing concrete actions/projects in line with this purpose.

“Safety, Navigation and Environment”

Main goals

- ❖ Set up and develop an **innovative educational project** on Multimodal Carriage (especially the maritime one), Port Logistics and environmental challenges from which the maritime entrepreneurs may benefit;
- ❖ Foster young people being willing to either gain a **professional characterization** or to improve their own **technical knowledge**;
- ❖ **Facilitate the interplay between actors** carrying out multi-modal carriage and port logistics services;
- ❖ **Improve the attractiveness of the productivity** and service chain by **promoting the sector** of multimodal carriage and port logistics;
- ❖ **Foster the entrepreneurial spirit** through the explanation of chances and obstacles that currently hinder the development of far-reaching and high-potential chains, such as that concerning multi-modal carriage and port logistics;
- ❖ **Facilitate the cultural and generational exchange** among people coming from different countries and universities from Europe and the Mediterranean;
- ❖ **Shorten the distance between European citizens and European institutions** organizing presentations and discussions on the European and Mediterranean related policies in matter of multi-modal carriage, port logistics and environment

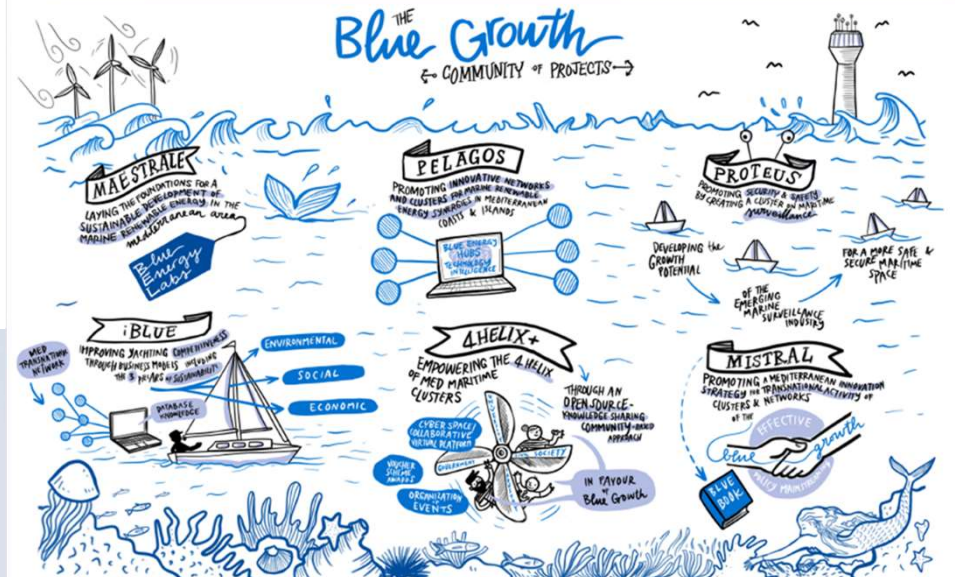

“Study Blue” Summer School – Kotor (July 2019)

“Blue Growth: Emerging technologies, Trends and opportunities”

Context

❖ Organised in the framework of the Interreg MED Blue Growth Community, the Summer School was held at the **University of Montenegro from 1 to 5 July 2019**. The educational project proposed was built on the experience and expertise of the Blue Growth Community. It represented an excellent occasion for participants from different countries and backgrounds. Through the specific theme courses, workshops and **to gain an updated overview and a better understanding of the sector's state-of-the-art, challenges and opportunities, in an outstanding international context.**

❖ working labs offered – covering different areas of the blue economy – the Summer School aimed at **encouraging young people involvement in blue economy sectors** by offering high-quality technical knowledge and fostering their entrepreneurial spirit. Moreover, it aimed at contributing to improve the attractiveness of maritime jobs as well as the employability of graduates.

❖ The Summer School was organised over 5 full days: 4 days dedicated to trainings, with a sound repartition of contents between classes, workshops and study visits, and 1 day for an open seminar and graduation ceremony, during which the trainees were able **to present a preliminary project** they developed during the previous days (on the 5 pillars of BG), as well as receiving their **graduation certificate**. This multidisciplinary approach allows to combine interactive workshop classes and rigorous academic training with a unique technical expertise and international excellence.

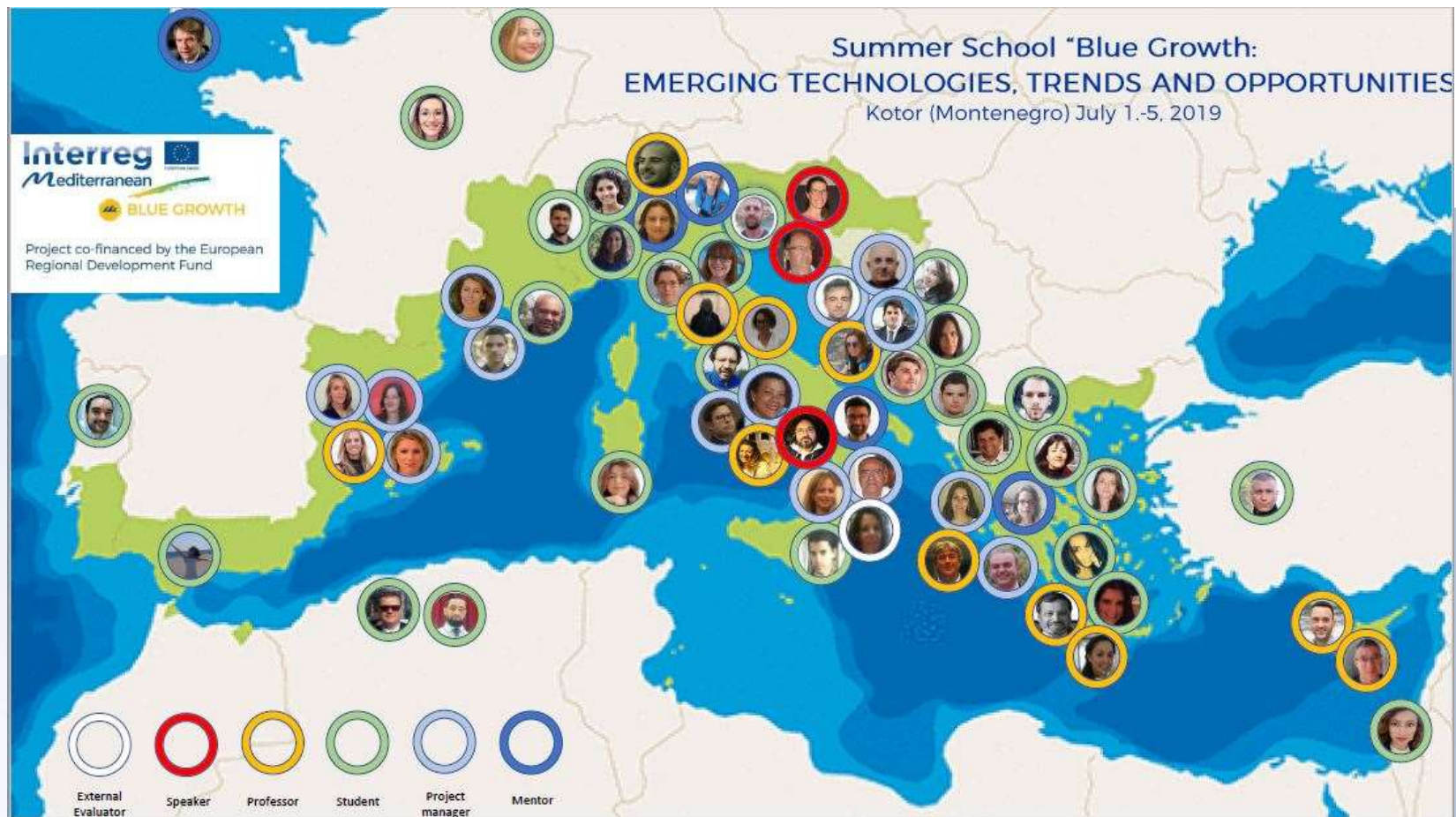
